

General healthcare services in Singapore

Singapore's modern healthcare system comprises private hospitals, public (government) hospitals and specialist clinics, each specializing in different patient needs, at varying costs.

For emergency services, patients can go at any time to the 24-hour Accident and Emergency Departments located in the government hospitals. Dial 995 if you need an ambulance urgently, otherwise dial 1777. There are many private clinics, some of which also operate 24-hour services (charges are higher from 10.00pm to 8am).

International Students holding a Student's Pass are covered under the school's Group Hospitalisation and Surgical Insurance. However, this insurance policy does not cover the cost of any out-patient treatment. Therefore, students are advised to take out additional medical insurance before coming to Singapore.
